3 Payment terms

This document only relates to your tuition fees. The student will encounter other (incidental) costs related to your study such as: food, entertainment, medical certificates, police checks, remedial training etc. These are summarised under Appendix A of this form but is not included as part of your Schedule of Fees or your Fees agreement.

The fees calculated are based on the student completing the course/s in the timeframe specified and meeting all competencies according to the delivery schedule. Remedial training or re-sitting exams will incur additional costs. Incidentals are generally paid to third-party organisations and are not refundable.

Payment options: Payment can be made via credit card, bank deposit or cash. Please refer to your invoice or the 'Next Steps' section in your enrolment confirmation pack for details.

3.1 Course Deposit

- 3.1.1. AIAC do not charge an Application fee.
- 3.1.2. To secure your place in our program a Course Deposit of \$10,000 is payable 3 days after you have received your visa.
- 3.1.3. Course deposit is Non-Refundable and is used to source your study resources, pilot equipment, uniforms, secure your accommodation, arrange transport from Sydney Airport and assist you in your visa process.
- 3.1.4. The course deposit is part of your total tuition fees.
- 3.1.5. Failure to pay the deposit by the due date may see your enrolment cancelled.
- 3.1.6. A security bond of \$1000 is required to cover any damage caused by the student. This will be returned at Graduation pending accommodation inspection.

3.2 Course Fees

- 3.2.1. AIAC is not approved under the Governments VET Student Help Loan scheme. All fees must be paid for by the student.
- 3.2.2. All tuition fees are exclusive of GST.
- 3.2.3. Remaining tuition fees are paid by phases
- 3.2.4. The first payment for your remaining tuition fees, covering Phase 1 of your training, is due 7 days prior to arrival in Australia. AIAC cannot finalise your enrolment until this is paid.
- 3.2.5. Remaining fees are to be paid 7 days in advance before starting a phase.
- 3.2.6. Fees not received on or before the due date will cause AIAC to 'stop training'. The student will not be able to incur further costs until the fees are paid. This may threaten the ability of the student to complete the course within the specified study period.
- 3.2.7. Where fees are not paid on time, a late payment fee of \$150 will be applied to your invoice to cover administration costs.
- 3.2.8. Tuition fees include 1 (one) attempt at each flight test or CASA exam.
- 3.2.9. A student may pay more than 50% of the tuition fees before the course commences. The student must request this option in writing by emailing rt@aiacollege.com.
- 3.2.10. Where a student chooses to defer his/her studies, AIAC will hold all pre-paid fees.
- 3.2.11. Any fees for self-sponsored students that are paid prior to commencing study that are in excess of \$1,500AUD are protected in accordance with state regulations. Fees Paid in Advance will be protected by:
- An unconditional Bank Guarantee and kept in a separate, secure account with a recognised banking institution;
 - accessed only when the service is rendered on a week-by-week basis;
 - not used for any other purpose until the student has completed the subject relating to the balance of the fees.
- 3.2.12. Additionally, the Federal Government's Tuition Protection Service (TPS) is a initiative of the Australian Government to assist international students, whose education providers are unable to fully deliver their course of study. For more information, visit <https://tps.gov.au/Home>.

3.3 Course fee inclusions

 - Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC)
 - Pilot bag & equipment
 - Internet access at all locations
 - Transport to and from College/Classrooms
 - Briefings and all ground theory
 - Landing fees & airport charges
 - Pick up from Sydney Airport upon arrival
 - Shared, self-contained accommodation; including all utilities & internet access.
 - *AIAC reserve the right to charge students for excessive power, gas or water use.*

3.4 Course fee exclusions

- 3.4.1. Fees do not include the following, or any item listed in Appendix A;

- Remedial flight training where the student requires more than the minimum flight hours set out above.
- Additional flight tests
- Re-sitting any CASA exam
- Meals
- Any CASA applications for licenses, ratings or medicals
- ASIC application and Police Checks
- Accommodation where the student does not complete the course within the advertised timeframe.

3.4.1. Any additional charges incurred by the cadet in the course of training is to be settled in the final account reconciliation upon course completion. Payment is required before AIAC can issue any Certificate, Licence or Rating.

3.4.2. Incidental costs paid to AIAC are non-refundable.

3.4.3. Incidental costs paid to third-parties may or may not be refundable. Check with the provider for their refund policy.

3.5 Recognition of Prior Learning/Credit Transfer

3.5.1. The RPL/CT fee is \$3000 and non-refundable.

3.5.2. RPL/CT applications will only be accepted at the time of enrolment.

3.5.3. The RPL/CT fee includes a thorough assessment of your previous skills and knowledge, a Basic Aeronautical Knowledge exam, Aircraft familiarisation & quiz, an interview with our HOO and a flight test in an appropriate aircraft.

3.6 Payment Schedule

3.6.1. Fees are paid as a total of both diploma courses.

3.6.2. The total AVI50219 & AVI50519 combined fees are \$135,000 ex GST.

3.6.3. Excess fees paid during the CPL phases are used as the deposit for the IR course and is used to supply additional resources.

3.6.4. The excess prepaid fees paid under the CPL course towards the IR course are refundable under our Refunds policy.

3.6.5. The payment schedule is:

3.6.5.1. \$10,000 course deposit due 21 days prior to course commencement

3.6.5.2. 30% (or \$37,500) of total course fees less deposit payable 7 days prior to arrival into Australia.

3.6.5.3. 25% (or \$31,250) of total course fees less deposit payable by week 17 and prior to RPL test (whichever is earlier).

3.6.5.4. 20% (or \$25,000) of total course fees less deposit payable by week 30 or commencement of Phase 6 (CPL) (whichever is earlier).

3.6.5.5. *Total Course fees paid for AVI50219 = \$103,750. The additional \$6,750 is used as a deposit for the AVI50519 program to provide your study resources; or refunded if the student does not continue to the AVI50519 program.*

3.6.5.6. 25% (or \$31,250) of total course fees less deposit payable by week 37 or commencement of Instrument Rating (whichever is earlier).

3.6.5.7. *Total course fees paid for the AVI50519 program = \$38,000.*

3.7 Cancellation of enrolment

3.7.1. Students may cancel their enrolment without penalty prior to any fees or deposits being made.

3.7.1.1. *AIAC reserve the right to invoice the student if AIAC has already purchased OSHC or any other item related to your study.*

3.7.2. Cancellations after the deposit has been made, but before tuition fees have been made is non-refundable (the course deposit is non-refundable).

- 3.7.3. Cancellations after the first pre-paid tuition amount has been paid and before arrival into Australia, will incur a 10% administration fee of any tuition amount made to AIAC.
- 3.7.4. Cancellations after arrival into Australia and 3 days prior to the course commencement date will incur a 30% administration fee to cover associated costs.
- 3.7.5. Cancellations within 2 business days may not be refunded.
- 3.7.6. Course deposit & RPL/Credit transfer fees, and any payments made to third parties will not be refundable.

3.8 Changes to Fees

AIAC flight training is affected by a number of external influences which could cause possible fee fluctuations. For example, external factors such as fuel and government fees and charges could affect the cost of training. AIAC reserves the right to pass on fee increases where external factors affect the agreed upon cost of training. The student will be notified in writing 20 working days before any adjustments in fees will be implemented.

3.9 Cooling off Period

Generally, does not apply to education. A student may cancel enrolment without penalty before the course deposit has been paid. Once the deposit and required pre-paid tuition fees have been paid, fees will apply for any cancellations thereafter.

3.10 Additional Information

If the student requires excessive additional flight hours to complete training, his or her training may be stopped and the student will be deemed as not competent. The student may have to re-enrol in the course to continue studying. In this case, Recognition of Prior Learning may apply for any units of competencies that the student has previously shown to meet AIAC assessment standards. Course cancellation, re-enrolment and RPL will be assessed by the Chief Pilot in consultation with the involved flight instructors and the student. Failure to be able to meet competencies is a safety issue and the student may need to undertake further self-study before re-enrolling at AIAC. The student will be able to access our Complaints & Appeals policy if desired.
